Policy for School Uniform

SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

We believe that a school uniform is important:

- It looks smart
- Wears well
- Contributes to a sense of belonging
- Gives a common purpose
- Fosters a feeling of pride

We ask that all children wear the uniform and we encourage them to maintain a good standard of clean and tidy dress in school.

Our school uniform is as follows:

School Uniform:

(all items should be named)

Boys

Red & white school tie (*available in School - £3.00*)
Grey trousers
Grey socks
Grey pullover - *Drumahoe sweatshirt is acceptable*
White shirt
Black shoes
Polar Fleece-optional (*available in school £ 15.00*)

P .E. Uniform - 2 days per week

Drumahoe Sweatshirt (*available in school £10.00.*)
White polo shirt (*available in school £7.50*)
White or black shorts
Black / white gym shoes
Black jogging pants

Girls

Red & white school tie (*available in School - £3.00*)
Grey skirt / pinafore
Grey socks
Grey pullover/cardigan - *Drumahoe sweatshirt is acceptable*
White shirt
Black shoes
Polar fleece-optional (*available in school £15.00*)

Summer uniform - optional Red gingham dresses may be worn with official Drumahoe sweatshirt or the standard grey cardigan / jumper

P.E. Uniform - 2 days per week Drumahoe sweatshirt (*available in school £10.00*)
White polo shirt (*available in school £7.50*)
White or black shorts - cycling shorts are acceptable
Black / white gym shoes
Black jogging pants

Hair accessories such as slides, ribbons, bobbles etc. should be fairly simple and if possible in school colours.

Parents are asked to ensure that all items are labelled clearly with their child's name.

For safety reasons we ask that the children do not wear jewellery in school on P.E. days. This includes earrings of any kind.

P.E. Kit

For health and safety reasons it is important that children are properly dressed for any physical activity.

PE kit should be kept in a named drawstring bag.

PE kit should be kept in school and returned home for washing at regular intervals and at holidays. All items of PE clothing should be named.
