

Reminder - Educational Learning Packs – Collection Friday 12th February 2021

Five full weeks of remote learning have now been completed and a massive thank you to everyone for your continued hard work and commitment during these challenging times. Tomorrow is the last school day before our half-term holiday and you will all be glad to hear, that no work will be set for week commencing 15th February 2021!

Everyone enjoy your break next week because you all have certainly earned it – pupils, parents and staff.

Unfortunately, the lockdown period continues after half-term until at least Monday 8th March 2021 and staff have again been very busy creating the next 'Educational Learning Pack' (ELP 2) to support remote learning after the half-term break.

During this extended period of remote learning, we will continue to communicate through the main Seesaw/Google Classroom online platforms as well these hard copy materials.

The second 'Educational Learning Pack' (ELP 2) for each pupil will be available for you to collect for your child(ren) **TOMORROW - Friday 12th February 2021 between 8.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m.**

ELP 2, just like the previous one, will complement the online learning platforms of Seesaw/Google Classroom and will take your child(ren) up to Easter break ie. Friday 26th March 2021.

Although we patiently await the next update when the Executive reviews the current restrictions next week on Thursday 18th February 2021, we have put together sufficient work for 5 weeks in ELP 2 but are hoping that we will not require it all and will be back at school before then – fingers crossed!

To adhere with advice on social distancing guidelines we are asking that only one person (no families please) comes into the school building tomorrow (Friday) to collect the pack(s).

The packs, just like the last time, will be placed on the pupil's desks in the different classrooms and they must be signed for on the sheet provided (there will be a pen in each classroom but we advise you to bring your own for obvious reasons).

Please wear a face covering and sanitise your hands before entering the school building via the Main Front Door. Signage will direct you to the appropriate classrooms.

Leave the school building after collecting your pack(s) via the normal classroom exit door that your child would normally use which will assist us with social distancing guidance.

If your child is in school every day as a 'Key Worker/Vulnerable pupil' then the ELP 2 will stay in school and there is no need to collect it.
