## **Christmas Dinner:**

We are very much looking forward to holding our Festive Evening on Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> December. All orders are now being processed by the elves who are working hard to ensure everyone has a great night. Doors will open at 6p.m. and there will be a variety of craft stalls in attendance on the evening at which you can purchase some Christmas gifts as well as the very popular 100 stall, cake stall, Christmas Stall and bran tub. Kidz Farm will also be there on the night, which I know the children always enjoy. Admission on the evening is £1.00 and this will get you a cup of tea/coffee and a biscuit and will also allow the children to visit Kidz Farm on the evening.

## **P1 & School Enrolment**

School Enrolment Information on the procedures for school admissions in September 2023 should be available on the EA website [www.eani.org.uk/parents/admissions](http://www.eani.org.uk/parents/admissions) from 13<sup>th</sup> December 2022 for Pre-school/Primary 1 places and for Post-Primary places (Year 8 entry). Schools are currently updating criteria to send back to EA for Year 1 admissions. The dates given for the application process for Primary and Nursery schools currently is that it will go live on the EA website on the **Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> January 2023** at 12 noon, with a closing date for applications on **27<sup>th</sup> January 2023.**
